2. The 89th Regional Readiness Command is accepting applications for the non-nominative position of Command Sergeant Major, 6025 Garrison Support Unit (W7ZF01), 4301 Goodfellow Boulevard, St Louis, MO 63120. Request widest possible dissemination of this announcement to ensure all eligible CSMs have the opportunity to request consideration for selection.
3. SUMMARY OF DUTIES: The incumbent will serve as the Command Sergeant Major for the 6025th GSU (Riley). Serve as the principal advisor to the 6025th GSU Commander and members of the Staff on all enlisted issues to include personnel, training and readiness posture. Monitor and report all professional development trends to the Commander. Maintain liaison with the senior enlisted leadership throughout the 6025th GSU with higher headquarters, and professional military associations.
4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Command Sergeants Major and Sergeants Major with reappointment rights may submit applications for this position. TPU CSMs, IRR/IMA CSMs and AGR CSMs are eligible to apply. Current CSMs must ensure that they will be released from their assigned organizations.
5. An AGR CSM who is selected for this non-nominative position must be released from active duty to accept this position.

- b. Physically fit and able to promote the Army Physical Fitness Testing and Training Program.

- d. Able to complete four years of assignment prior to reaching MYOS or age 60.
- e. Possess broad technical and operational knowledge of Enlisted Personnel Management, Army Training Management System, Enlisted Advancement and Promotions System, Retention and Incentive programs, Noncommissioned Officer Education System (NCOES), the Noncommissioned Officer Evaluation System (NCOER) and Command Sergeants Major Selection and Management Program.
- f. Must be able and willing to perform duty and travel above the regularly scheduled IDT and AT.
- g. Must possess a Secret Security Clearance.
